

We shall continue to follow: Government Guidelines, VisitEngland, The National Tourist Board of England and World Travel & Tourism Council.

- Before any departures our vehicles are vigorously cleaned using anti-bacterial cleansers, this includes all touch surfaces, grab rails, seat belt buckles, armrests, glass, flooring and drivers area.
- Our drivers/staff have been instructed on Safe Operating procedures, as advised by our Government to ensure anti-bacterial cleaning is done every day and when our vehicles are away from our base and depot.
- At the time of printing, passengers are requested to allow us to temperature test them prior to boarding our vehicles and to inform staff of any changes in health whilst away on tour.

- Our vehicles are 'fogged" using an

- electronic machine & sanitiser periodically at our depot. Sanitised fog mist fills the vehicles interior to settle onto all areas, leaving no area untouched.
- Everything possible is done to ensure you travel in a clean environment, making you feel at ease, especially, as we travel out of the Covid pandemic, we shall continue to provide personal safety packs to all our passengers containing individual hand sanitizer gel, tissues and wipes.





Upon receipt by us of your deposit we shall send you a confirmation letter. The invoice for the balance will be sent to you 8/6 weeks before the date of departure. Every person making a booking on behalf of a passenger or group of passengers warrants and confirms that he/she has the authority of that passenger and that each such passenger agrees to be bound by these Terms and Conditions.

More than 42 days prior to the start of your holiday, you will only be charged your deposit.


